<p>PROJECT OBJECTIVES:</p> <p>To establish a vegetarian resto in Cagayan de Oro city as a means of connecting people to the gospel message through the unique preparation of delicious and nutritious food, healthy lifestyle education programs, availability of free health assessments, spiritual seminars and medical missionary related training programs. To create a business model which is self-sustaining and in line with the blue print provided by God's messenger.</p>	
<p>PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The vegetarian resto will be operated directly by YourHealth Tomorrow, Inc. in association with ASI-SPUC. YourHealth Tomorrow, Inc. is a corporation based in Cagayan de Oro city with the passion to provide health assessment, health education and intervention programs to the community. The vegetarian resto will have a sanitary kitchen and will provide healthy and nutritious food for customers. A function room will also be available for health assessment, and intervention programs as well as training for medical missionary work. The project will be established within 3 months and operation will start within 4-6 months. The corporation will ensure that ROI will be within 2-3 years.</p>	
<p>PROJECT BACKGROUND: ASI-SPUC has recently been in talks with YHTI to form a partnership in establishing a "Center of Influence" for the city of Cagayan de Oro and nearby regions. The primary focus of the project is create a vegetarian restaurant which is profitable and self-sustaining. The restaurant will also provide an avenue to meet people with health challenges and provide health education programs and services to address the need. Other programs will also be made available as agreed upon by the stakeholders namely YHTI and ASI-SPUC. YHTI will be responsible for the licensing requirements, training of staff, daily operation and create periodic reports and summaries as required by government regulatory agencies. The restaurant will operate similar to other restaurants except that its food are uniquely healthy and delicious. The staff will undergo training in vegetarian food preparation under Lorna Gabuco an established vegetarian chef based in Luzon. Menus and equipment specifications will be provided by Lorna Gabuco.</p>
